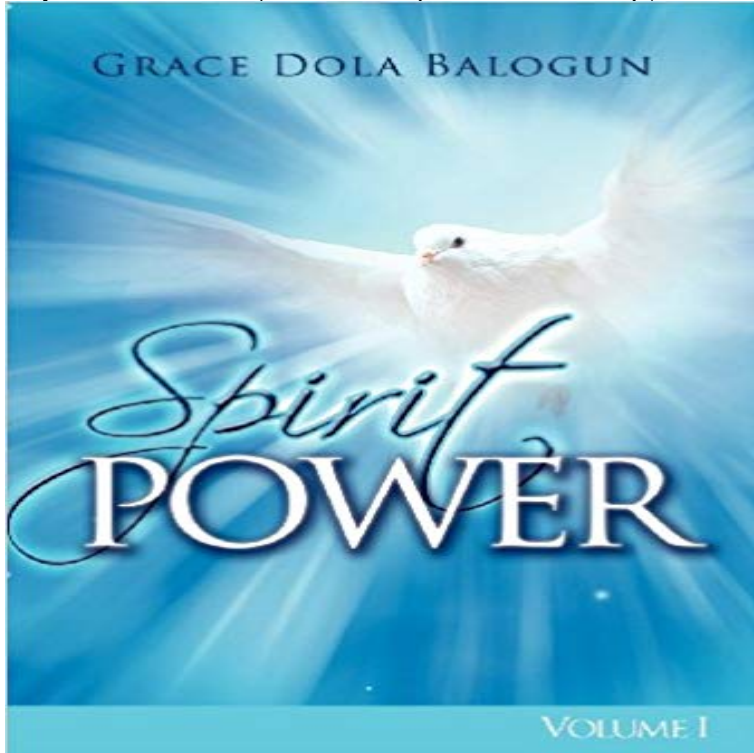


Spirit Power, Vol. 1 (Middle English Edition)
