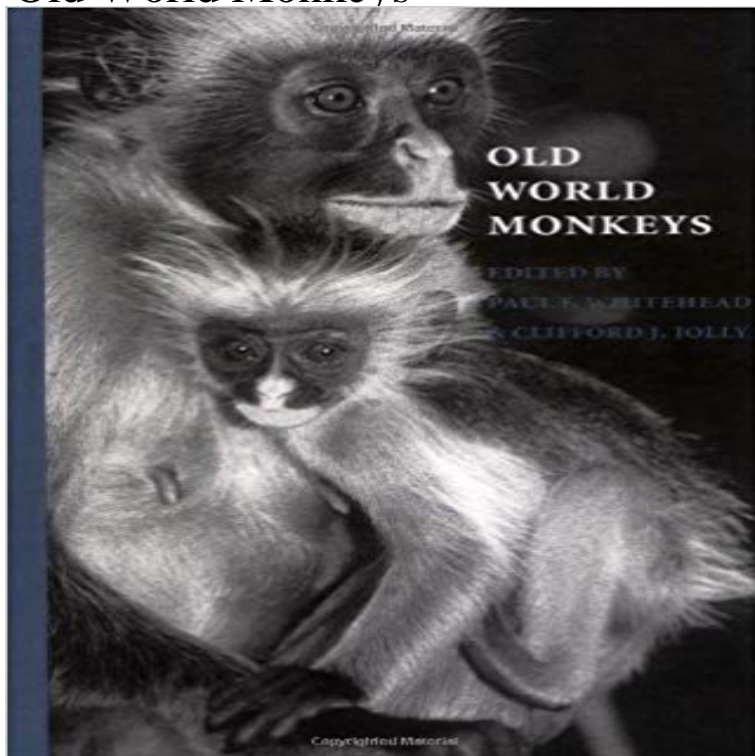


Old World Monkeys
