
Wildflowers of the Appalachian Trail

Also included are citations to more than 60 additional species, with respect to their distinguishing features. Yet this is no ordinary field guide. In addition to being able to identify a particular flower, you will also learn the story behind its name, the fascinating role it has played through history, and its value in folkloric and modern medicine. You will discover that Skunk Cabbage produces its own heat (often melting snow and ice around it) and that Bloodroot contains an anti-plaque agent used in toothpastes and mouthwashes. Unlike any other resource, this book notes specific sites along the Appalachian Trail where flower species may be seen; each site mentioned can be found in the index of its respective Appalachian Trail Guide.
